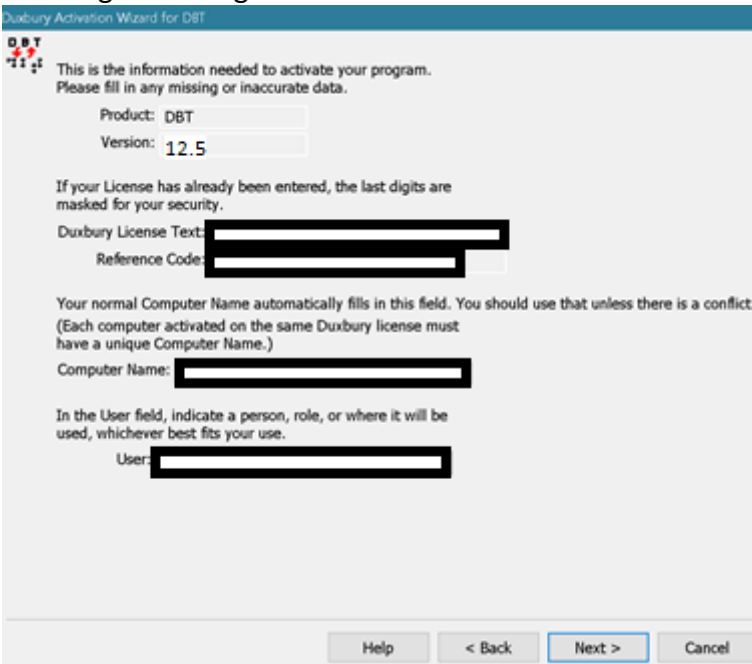

### Installation

- Go to the [Duxbury Demo page](#) to download a demo version of Duxbury 12.6
- Once downloaded, run the file to install Duxbury.
- On the "Customer Information" dialogue box of the installation wizard include the following information
  - User Name: Department of Education
  - Organisation: Department of Education
  - License Text: Leave blank

### Activation

- Launch DBT 12.6
- Ensure you have access to the internet as it is needed for the activation.
- Click on the option to "Activate".
- The activation code is emailed to the student's Visiting Teacher. This should go in the "Duxbury License Text" box in the activation wizard.
- Please make note of the computer name that is auto filled on the same screen, and email this to [vision.tech.library@education.vic.gov.au](mailto:vision.tech.library@education.vic.gov.au) to assist with deactivation if something goes wrong.



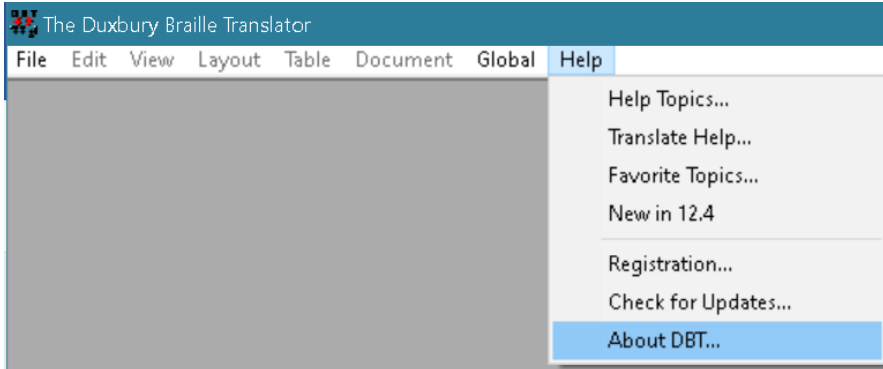
- Enter the following information in to register the license
  - Organisation: Statewide Vision Resource Centre

- Continue through the wizard to complete the activation.

## De-activation

- To return the Duxbury License to the library, it needs to be deactivated.
- Go into Duxbury and click on Help → About Duxbury



- In the dialogue box, click "De-Activate" and follow through until the deactivation is complete.
