The person installing/authorising/uninstalling Openbook must be logged in with the Admin password.

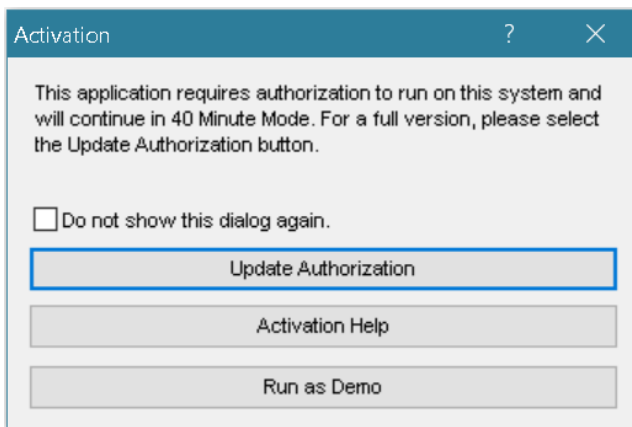

Installation

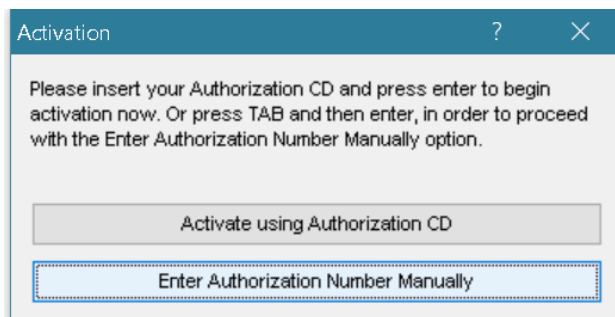
- Go to the Freedom Scientific website to [download Openbook](#).
- Once downloaded, run the file to install Openbook.
- During the installation process, you may be asked to "Modify", "Repair" or "Remove" Openbook. Choose "Modify", then click "Next" to continue with the installation.

Authorisation

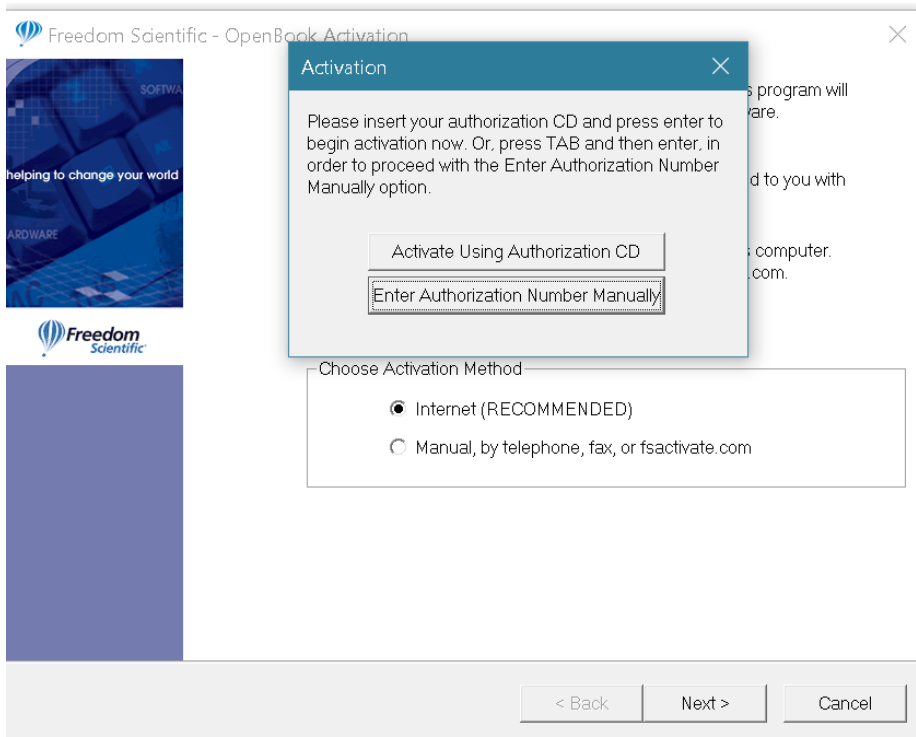
- Run Openbook. You will automatically be asked to "Update Authorisation" to activate the license.



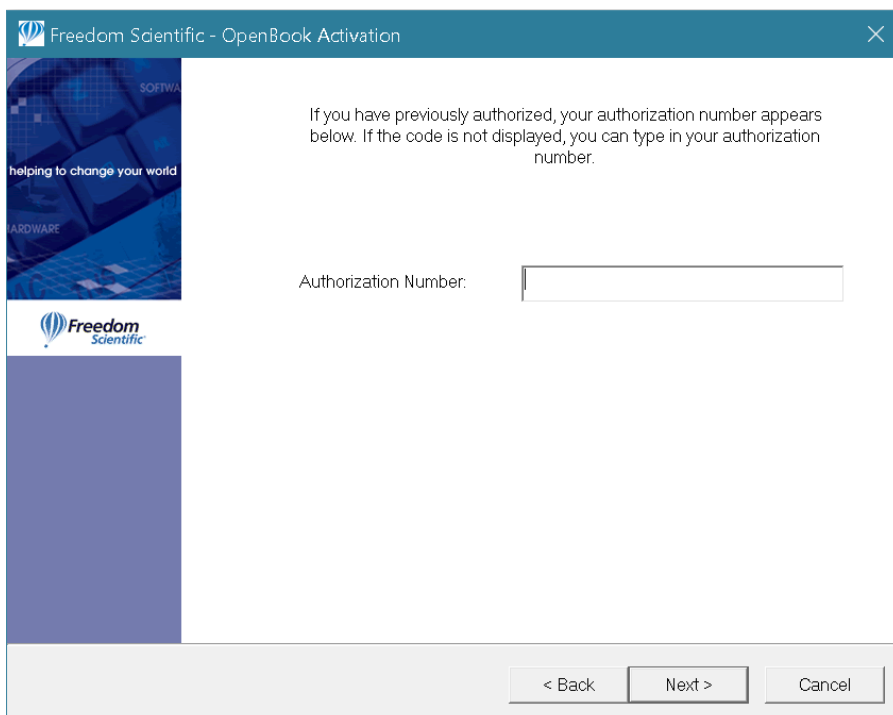
- Choose "Enter Authorisation number manually"



- Ensure you have access to the internet as it is needed for the authorisation. You will be asked again to confirm that you are entering the authorisation number manually.



- The authorisation code is in the email sent to the student's Visiting Teacher. You can also email vision.tech.library@education.vic.gov.au to get the authorisation code.



Uninstallation

- Openbook cannot be deactivated like other software, but it can be uninstalled through Windows Add/Remove programs.
