The person installing/authorising/de-authorising Fusion must be logged in with the Admin password.



Installation


- Go to the Freedom Scientific website to download Fusion.
- Once downloaded, run the file to install Fusion.
- Please note the Fusion is combination of both JAWS and Zoomtext, so three shortcuts will appear on the homescreen.

Authorisation

• Run Fusion. You will automatically be asked to "Update Authorisation" to activate the license.




Ensure you have access to the internet as it is needed for the authorisation.


• During setup you may be prompted to register. If you're asked to register any details please use the following:


De-authorisation
